## **Arrival & Dismissal Procedures**

- Upon arrival, all parents/guardians must remain in the lobby. Heart Studios' staff will assist with check-in and check-out.
- Drop-off begins at 9:00 AM, and pick-up is at 3:30 PM. Doors open at 8:55 AM.
- Extended care is available for early and late drop-off:
  - Morning: 8:00 AM – 9:00 AM
  - Afternoon: 3:30 PM – 4:30 PM
- Campers will remain in the classroom until their pick-up person arrives.
- For a smooth and safe dismissal:
- Please provide your child's number at the front desk.
- For safety, the front and back doors will remain locked during camp hours. If you need to pick up your child early, please call ahead so we can assist you at the door.

## **Health & Safety**

- Hand washing and sanitizing will take place before and after snacks and lunch.
- Students may not share food with others.
- We are a peanut-free facility—please do not send any food containing peanuts or peanut butter.
- During lunch and breaks, the art room and all supplies will be disinfected using FDA-approved cleaning products.

## **Behavior & Wellbeing**

- At Heart Studios, we strive to provide a safe, supportive, and creative environment for all of our students.
- If a student is exhibiting behavior that could potentially cause harm to themselves or others, we may need to contact a parent or guardian for early pick-up. In some cases, the student may not be able to continue attending camp for their safety and the safety of others.
- We are always happy to work with families to ensure students have a positive experience, and we encourage open communication if your child has any specific needs or concerns.

## **Personal Belongings & Electronics**

- We encourage students to leave personal electronics at home, including phones, tablets, handheld gaming devices, and smartwatches.
- If a student does bring a device, it must remain stored away during camp hours unless otherwise approved by a staff member for educational or emergency purposes.
- Heart Studios is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items, so we recommend leaving valuable items at home.

## Snacks & Lunch

- Heart Studios will provide one snack each day for all students.
- Students are welcome to bring their own additional snacks or lunch, especially if they have specific dietary needs.
- Please send a sack lunch and a refillable water bottle labeled with your student's name.
- We are a peanut-free facility—please do not send any food items containing peanuts or peanut butter.
- Students may not share food with others.
- All students will wash or sanitize hands before and after eating.

## What to Wear

- Art can get messy—in the best way! Please dress your student in comfortable clothes that can get paint or other materials on them.
- Closed-toe shoes are recommended for safety.

## Lost & Found

- Please label all personal items with your student's name.
- Any lost items will be placed in our Lost & Found bin.

## Code of Conduct

- We are committed to creating a welcoming and respectful environment for all students.
- Kindness, listening, and cooperation are expected from everyone.
- If there are repeated behavior concerns, parents will be contacted to help find the best solution for the student and the group.
